## Action Taken Report 2022-23 (Based on Feedback on Curriculum and Syllabus)

Based on the feedbacks received from students, alumni, teachers, and parents, the College has decided and taken measures to enhance its quality.

1. The Management has decided and appointed more qualified faculty.
2. Teachers are instructed to give syllabus plan/activity to the students well in advance. Students are advised to follow up with their teachers.
3. Regarding internal evaluation and assessment, students and teachers are required to maintain strict discipline. The Principal of the college reviews 5% of the exam/test papers to ensure further transparency.
4. More emphasis is given in identifying advanced and slow learners, and taking up remedial measures to enhance academic excellence of the students.
5. In regard to Library, the college has purchased more new books. Teachers are advised to suggest relevant books to be purchased.
6. Classrooms are made available with more comfortable seats and IT facilities.
7. Career Guidance and Placement cell was advised to conduct more career based programmes.
8. In regard to use of IT, the college is undertaking Computer training in collaboration with NIELIT. Teachers are asked to make use of IT facilities/tools in the teaching-learning process.
9. Parents are also informed to keep in contact with the college about their ward(s) studying in the college.
10. To cater to skill development of the students, the College undertakes short term certificate courses on Skill Development in collaboration with Government and Non-Government Agencies.

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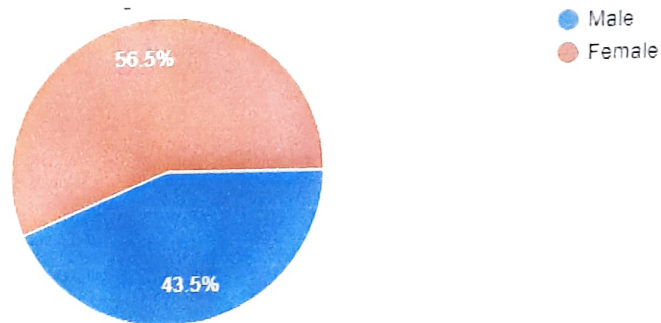


## Feedback on Curriculum and Syllabus by Alumni Academic Year 2022-23

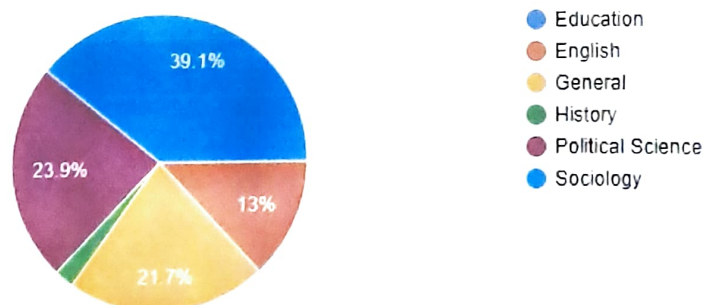

The chart given above shows the department wise distribution of the respondents.





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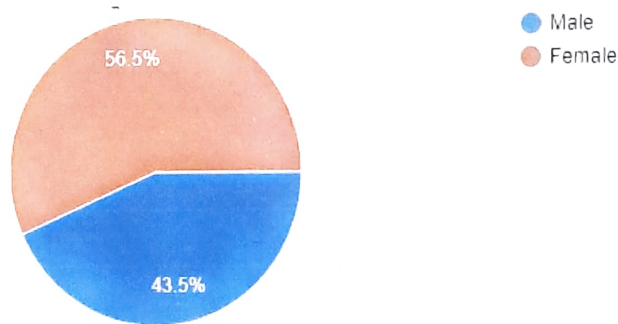

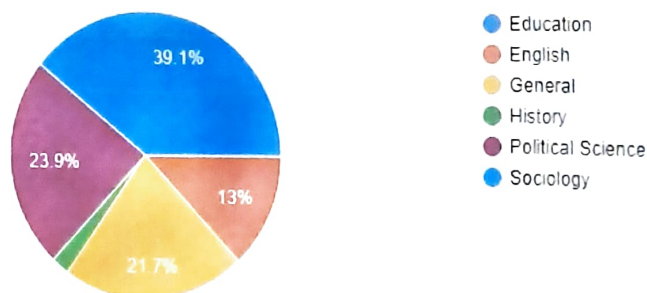

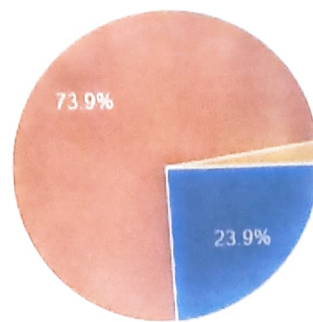


The chart given above shows the department wise distribution of the respondents.

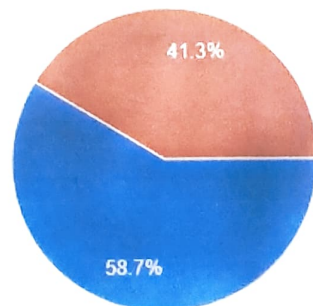

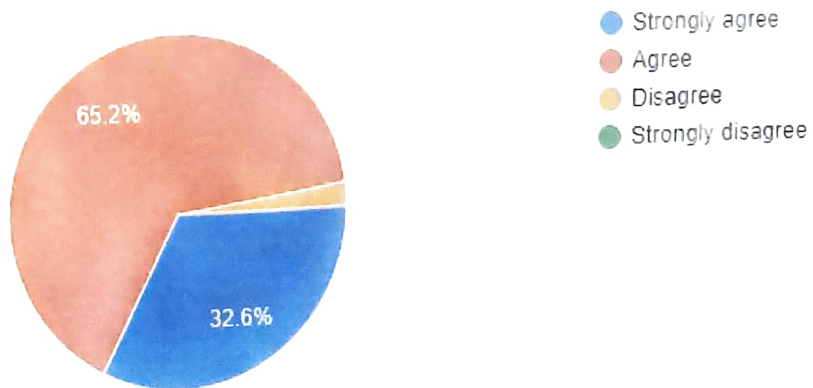

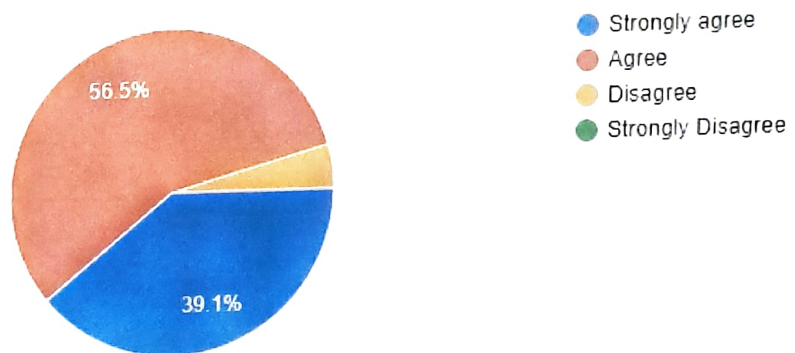

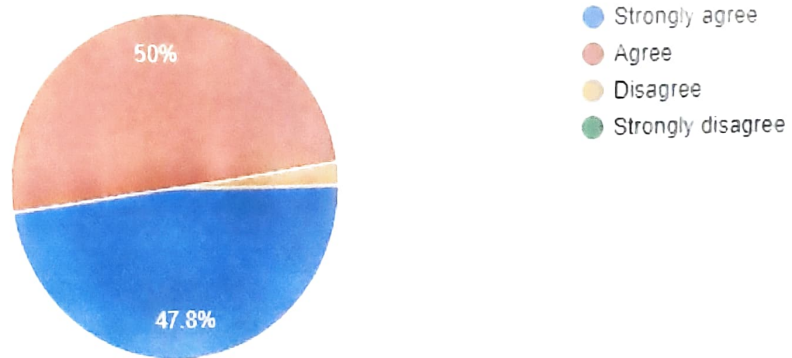

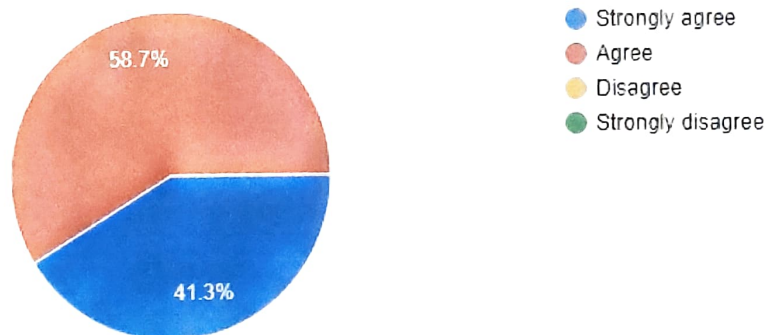

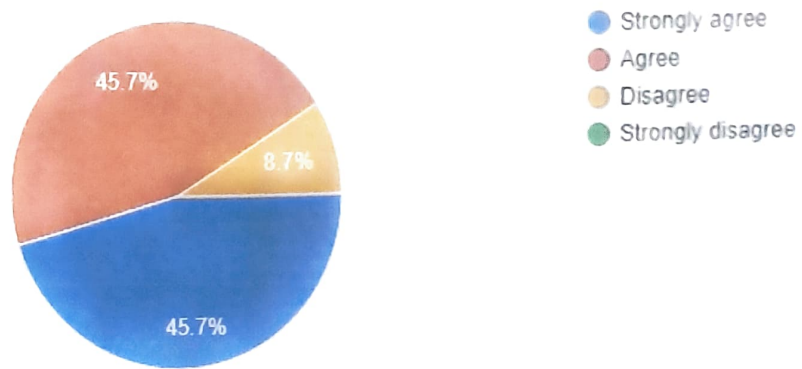

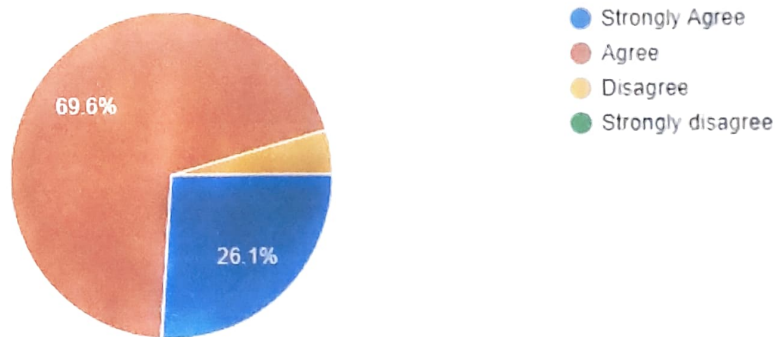

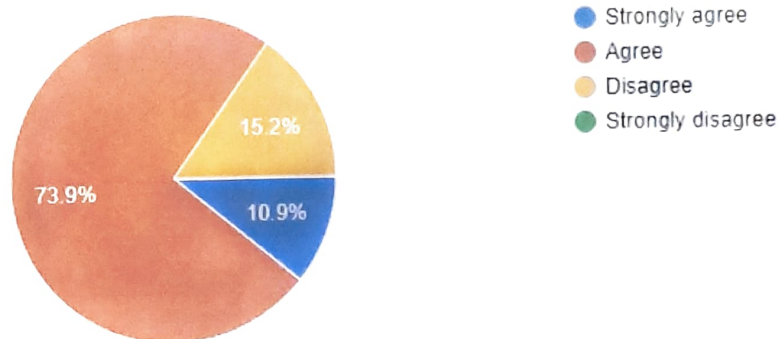

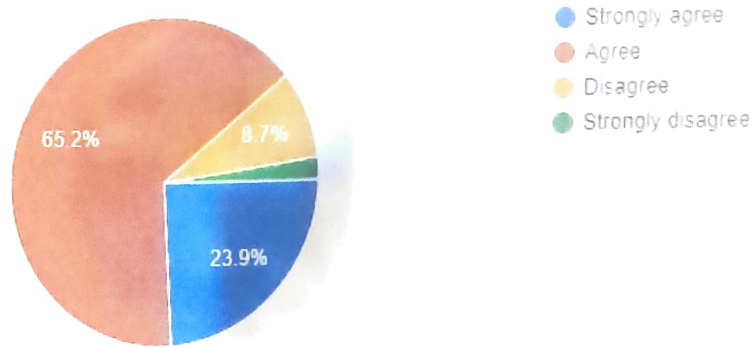

I am satisfied with the internal evaluation methods and criteria used in the college.

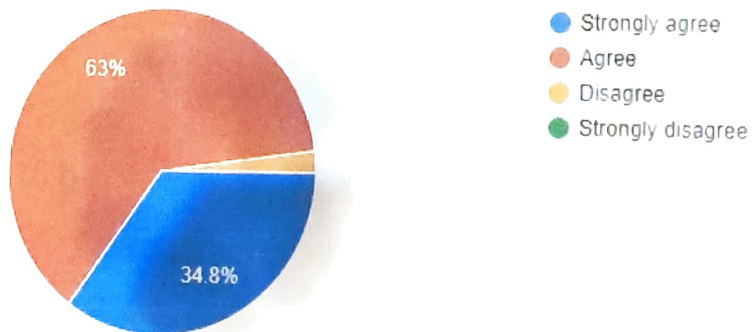

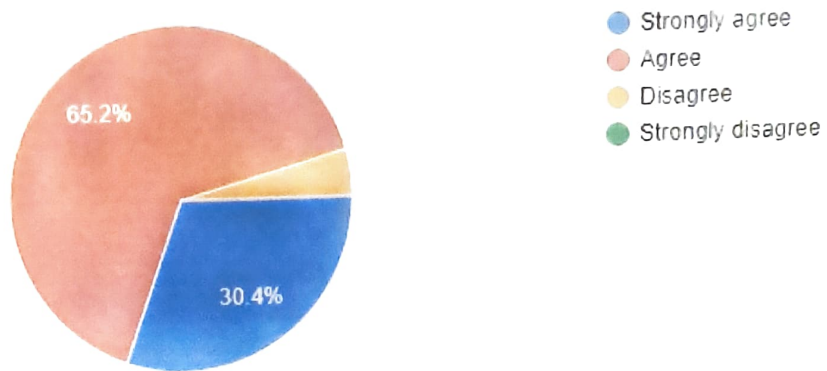


The respondents (alumni) in general are agreeing that the faculty gave orientation to students on career and higher education.



Overall I am fully satisfied with the teaching-learning delivery of the college.

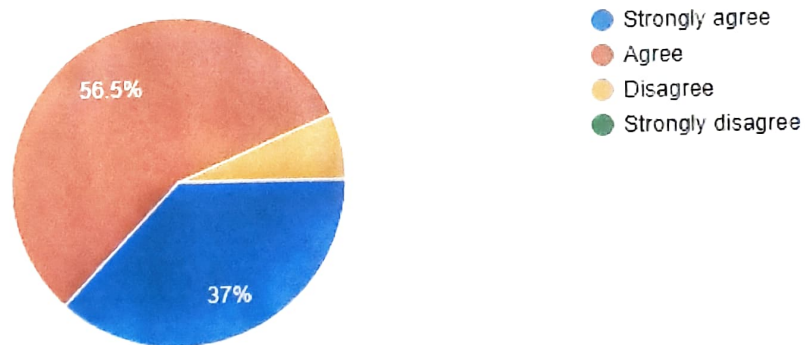

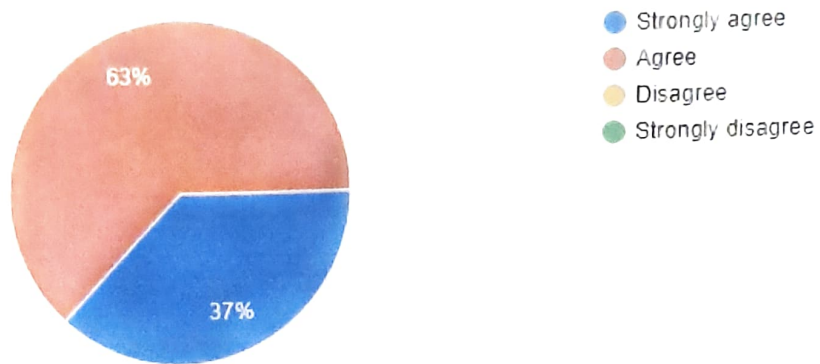

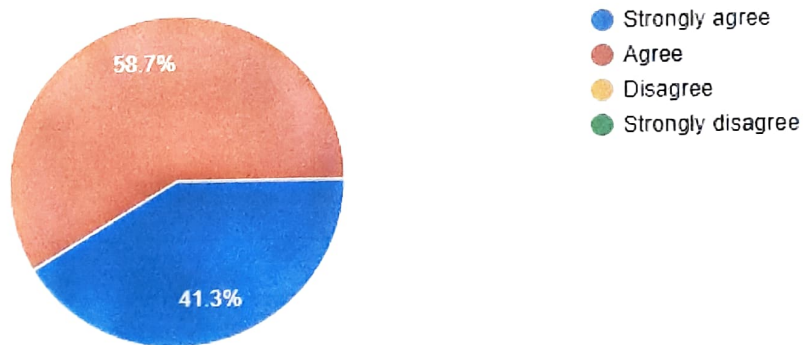

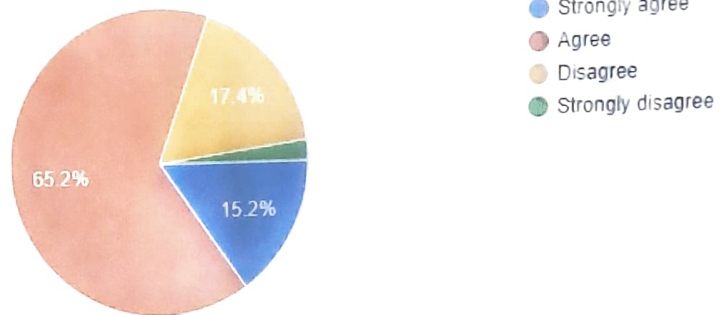

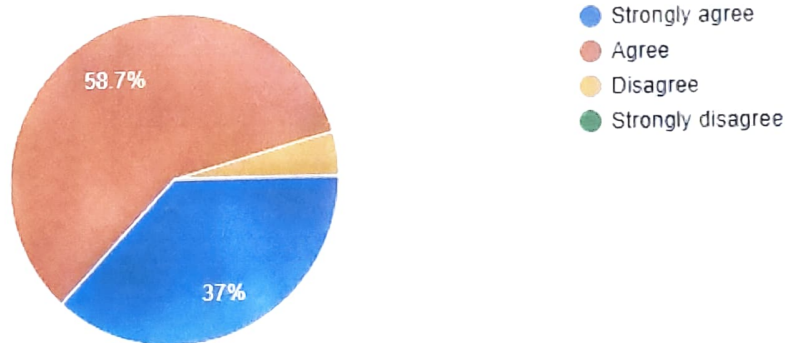

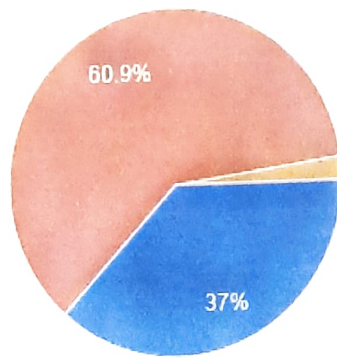

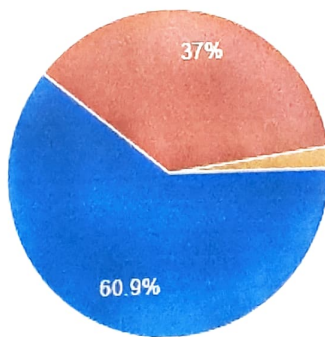

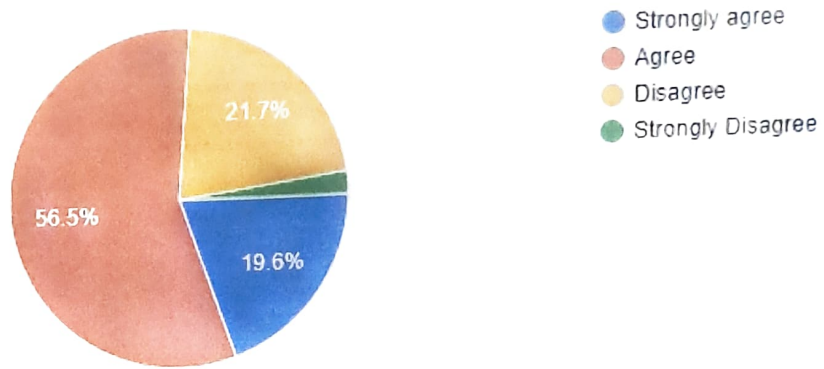

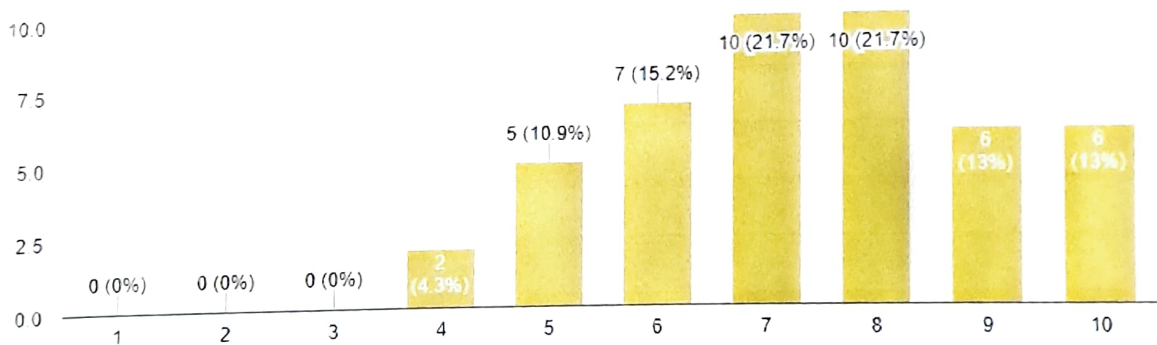


While, 76.1% of the respondents (alumni) are agreeing that the college has adequate collection of well-maintained books in the library, 23.9% of the respondents disagreed to it.

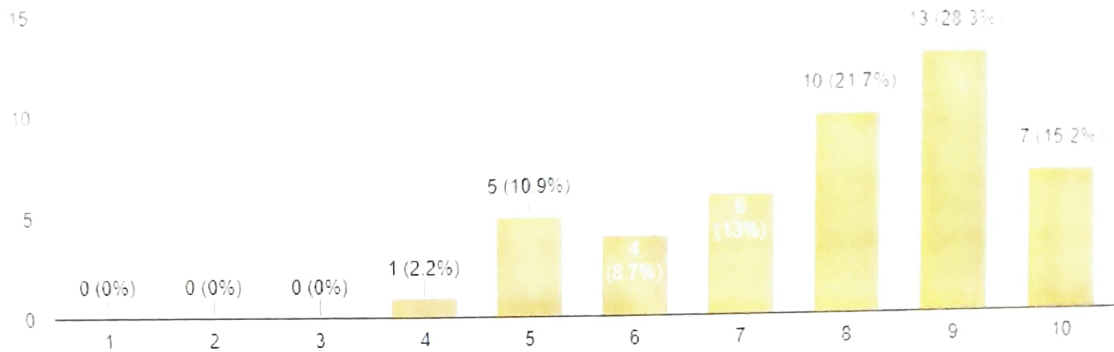

How would you rate the skills obtained for the following from the learning in the college: (B) Self confidence

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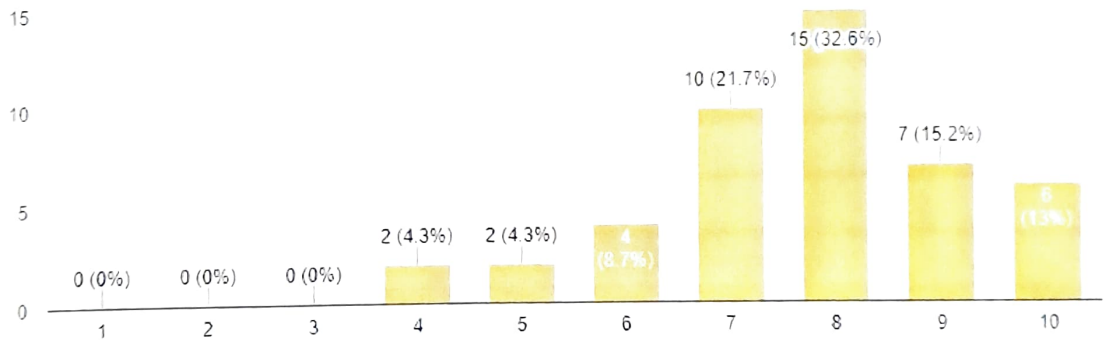

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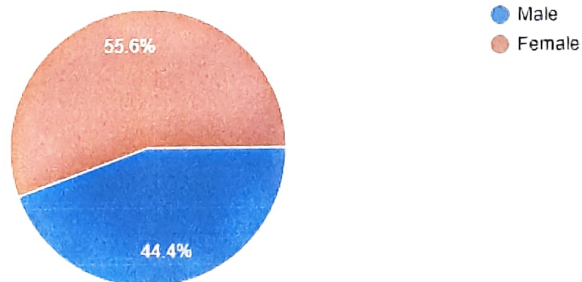
## Feedback on Curriculum and Syllabus by Teachers Academic Year 2022-23

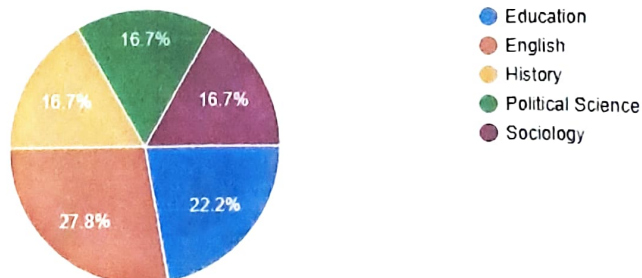

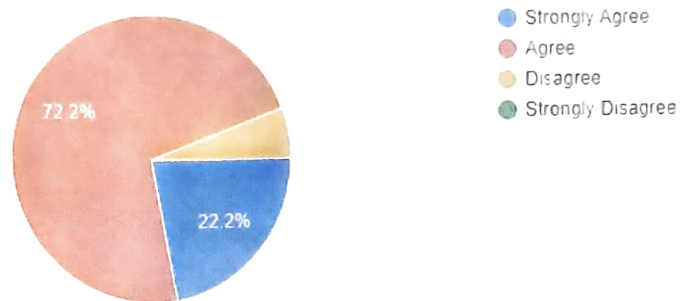

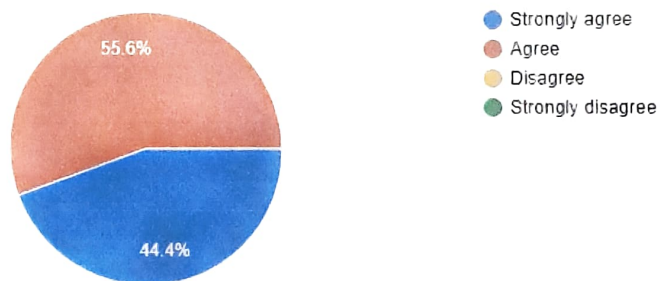

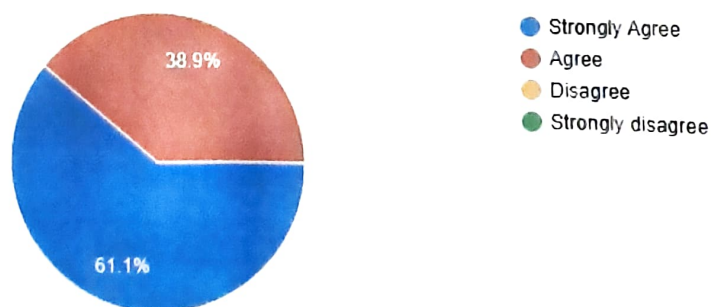

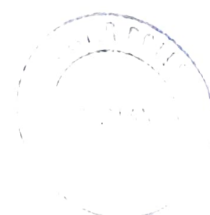

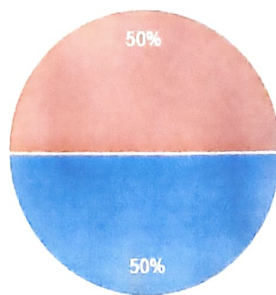

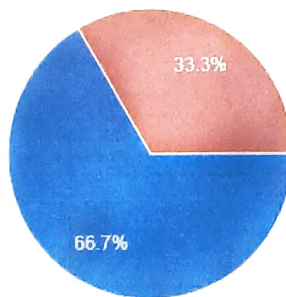

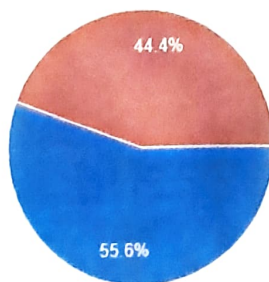

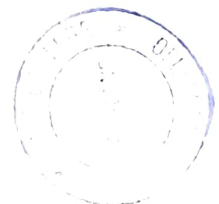

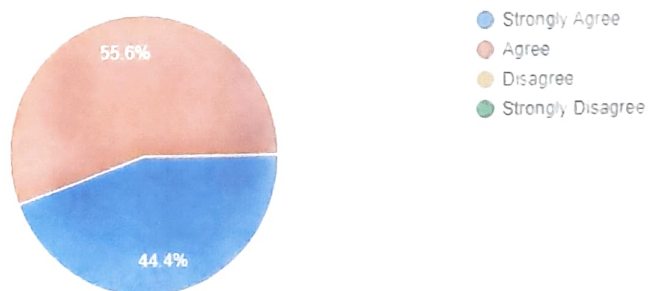

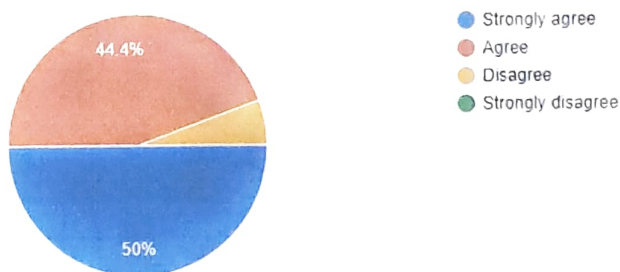

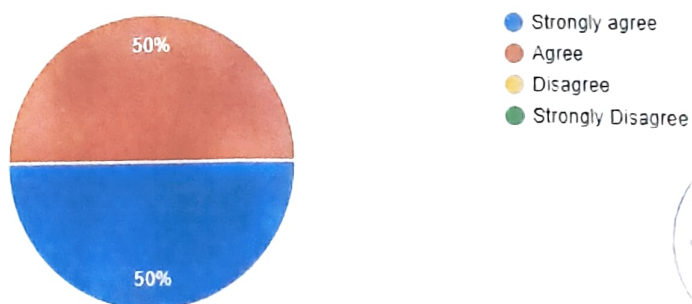

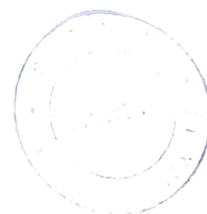

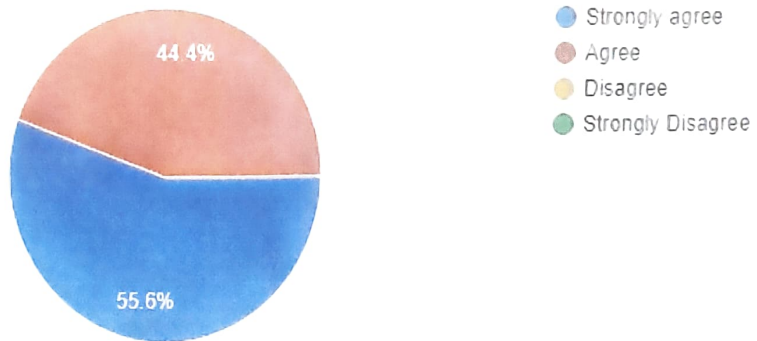

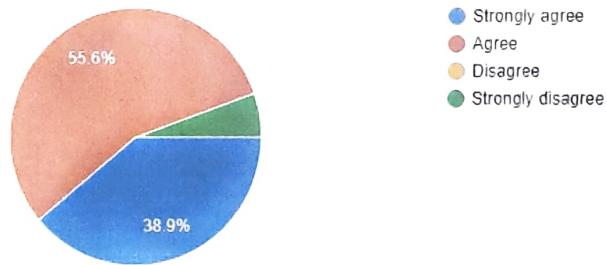

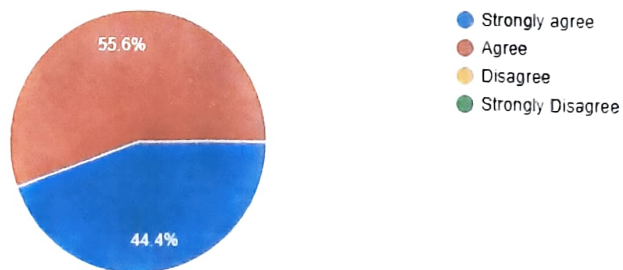

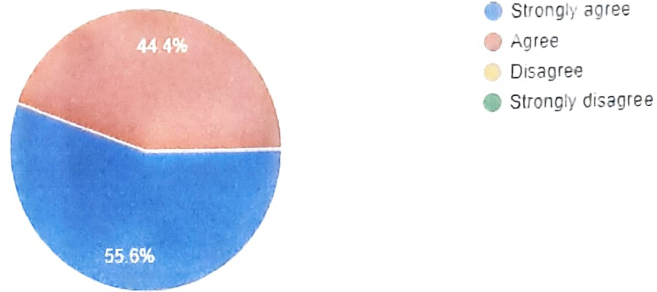

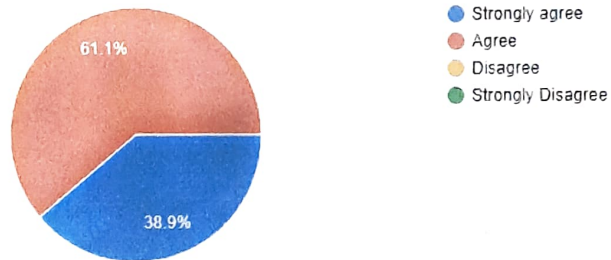

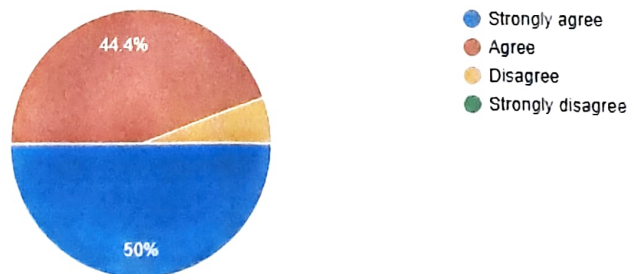

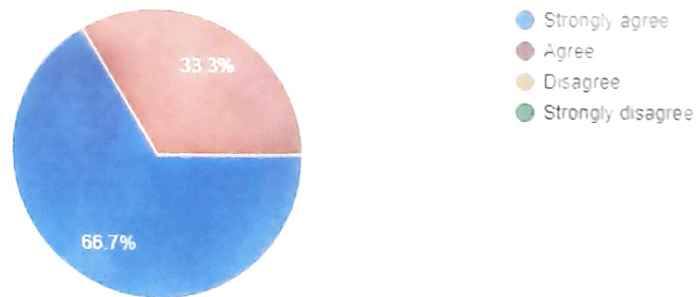

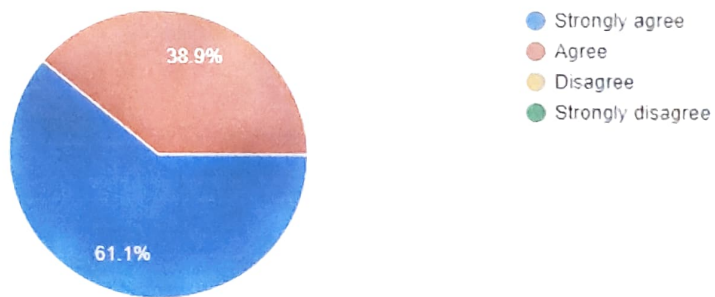

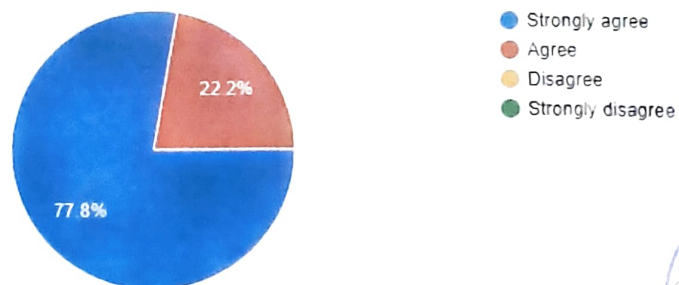

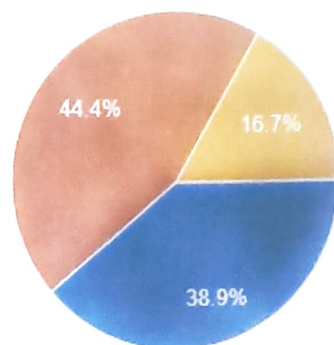

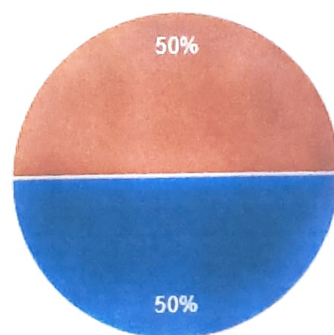
