



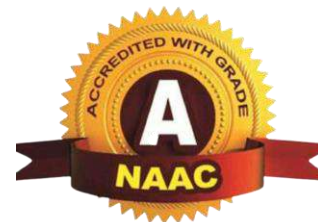

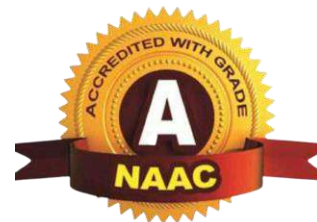

The seminar concluded at 2:30 with vote of thanks delivered by Aluibe of 6th semester followed by photo session and light refreshment.





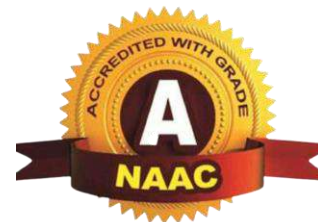

REPORT ON NCC C CERTIFICATE

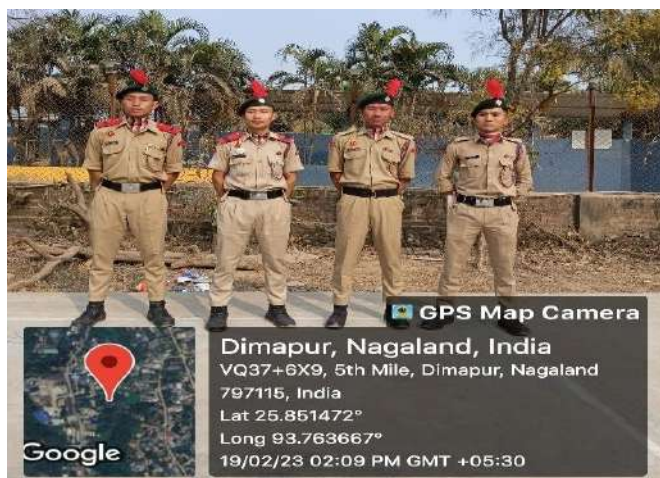

The program ended with a photo session.





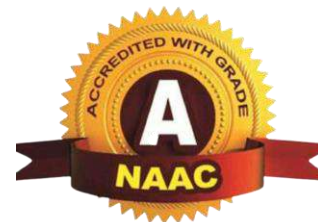

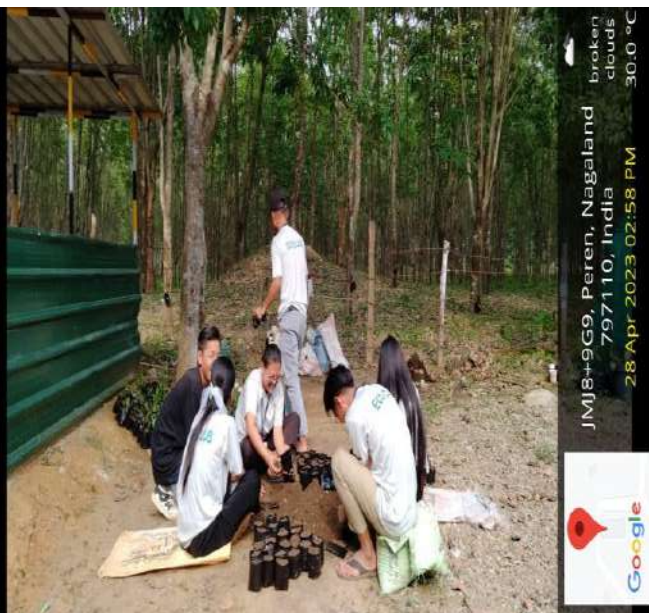


Report on Plantation Drive

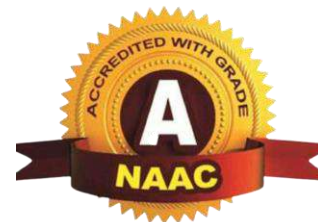

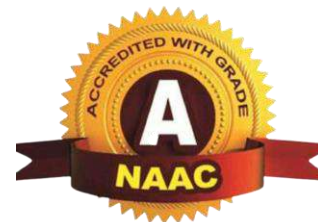
